Outstanding Member The purpose of the Outstanding Member Award is to honor those Young Farmer members who exemplify and promote the ideals of the State Association of Young Farmers of Texas and the agriculture industry.

Star Young Farmer/Agribisiness The applicant must receive more than 50% of his/her annual NET income from agricultural related career.

Star Young Farmer/ Agribisiness The purpose of the Young Farmer Family of the Year Award is to honor family units who are involved in their community and exemplify the traditional values of family life. In addition, the Young Farmer family promotes the ideals of the State Association of Young Farmers of Texas and the agriculture industry. Does not have to be Husband/Wife, Could be Brothers, Sisters, Dad/Son, Etc.

Young Farmer Newcomer The purpose of the Newcomer Award is to recognize first or second year members of the Young Farmers who have shown participation in the Texas Young Farmers at the state level as well as with their local chapter.

Sundowner

The applicant must receive less than 50% of his/her annual NET income from agriculture. This award is designed for an individual who derives their major portion of income from non-agricultural sources, but has an additional source of income from an agricultural source. Ideally, he/she should work at one occupation most of the time and conduct the agricultural activities "after 5:00 pm" and on weekends.
